Plowing Services

Trigger Depth: 0.5" Walkways, Sidewalks, Ramps, Entrances, Trash Enclosures

Trigger Depth: 1-3" Driveways, Parking Lots, Access Roads

Snow Plowing All service areas need to be clear of snow during and after each storm, regardless of the time of day, or day of the week. Special attention should be given to ensure all service areas allow for the safe passage of vehicles and pedestrians during client business hours (**location hours**).
 The contractor is responsible for ensuring the following areas are clear of snow within four (4) hours of the end of the storm: Entrances/exits, stairs/ramps, walkways/sidewalks, trash enclosures, driveways, access roads and parking lots.
 The contractor will return the following day, or as requested, to clear spaces that were occupied by vehicles during the storm, or snow that has drifted into previously cleared areas.
 Snow totals will be verified on weatherworks.com.

Staking Prior to the first storm or the ground freezing, whichever happens first, the contractor will insert stakes 3" from the curbing in grassy areas bordering islands, sidewalks, and parking areas. Stakes will also be inserted around the outline of the entire service area. All stakes will be placed no more than 10' apart, or closer at the contractor's discretion.
 Where applicable, fire hydrants are to be marked with 6' stakes.
 All stakes will be removed by the contractor at the end of the season.

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Deicing Services

Pretreatment All service areas will be treated prior to the beginning of each snow or ice storm. Contractor will determine when to apply treatment based on current weather conditions, ground temperature, and forecasted weather conditions.

Deicing All service areas will receive additional treatments with deicing solution anytime ice has formed and an area becomes a safety concern. Contractor must be aware of current weather conditions and ground temperature to ensure the client receives enough applications to provide safe conditions.

Product Approved products, per environmental regulations, include Ice B'Gone Magic & Liquid Ice B'Gone. Sand and/or salt may be used with advanced permission only.

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Property Damage

Prior to the start of service, ONE SOURCE will perform a walk through with the contractor and take photos of all parking lots, curbing, walkways, entrances, and trash enclosures. The contractor will be responsible for repairing damages that they cause that may occur during the season. If damage occurs while plow services are being performed, the contractor must immediately call ONE SOURCE at (866) 708-6736, option 1, to provide a detailed incident report. If the contractor is unable to complete repairs themselves, ONE SOURCE may make repairs on the contractor's behalf. Payment arrangements can be made, or ONE SOURCE may reserve the right to deduct from the balance owed to the contractor for services rendered.

All repairs will be completed no later than May 31st, 2020.

Damage caused by others (mail delivery, trash pickup, etc.) can be repaired by ONE SOURCE, out of scope, at the client's expense.

Equipment

The contractor is responsible for ensuring they have sufficient equipment, supplies, and manpower available to properly meet the customer's needs before, during, and after each storm.

The contractor is not permitted to store any equipment onsite without prior written approval from the client. If the contractor is granted permission to store equipment on the client's property, neither the client or ONE SOURCE shall be held accountable if any damages occur.

All equipment and materials will be provided by the contractor. Neither the client nor ONE SOURCE are responsible for providing any of the supplies necessary to complete the job described in this scope.


